



CYCLING ROUTES

Route #1: The Foot (Red Signs) 58 km

 Prevailing winds, meandering roads through rural landscapes challenge the seasoned cyclist.

Route #2: The Head (Yellow Signs) 18 km

 Cycle along the shore of Lake Ontario through serene pastoral landscapes with great birding opportunities.

Route #3: Button Bay (Blue Signs) 28 km

 Rolling farmland, idyllic wetlands, rural architecture.

Extension to Big Sandy Bay (Green Signs)

Welcome to Wolfe Island, home to beautiful sunrises, breathtaking sunsets and enjoyable rural landscapes.

Cycling is a popular activity for the many visitors to the Island and can be a most pleasant and exhilarating experience for both the cyclists and the community when both sides practice safe riding habits. The routes provided attempt to take you on roads that are less traveled by motor vehicles but where this is not possible, please observe the rules of the road. In particular en-

sure that you travel as far to the right of the road as possible and obey all traffic signs and laws.

PLEASE; be kind to our environment and leave only footprints, use garbage cans located throughout our village of Marysville, respect private property, bring binoculars to capture those far off sights and wear a helmet.

0.0 km east on Main St. Depart Tourist Centre - through village
 0.6 km on right 7th Line Rd
 0.8 km on left Look for heron in the bay on right
 2.0 km on right 8th line Rd
 2.4 km on left Rte 7051 – winter ferry dock
 3.6 km crosses 9th Line Rd
 4.9 km crosses 10th Line Rd
 6.2 km right curve 11th Line Rd – on left
 6.8 km left turn Oak Point Rd – gravel, cows & horses
 8.2 km crosses 12th Line Rd – rural & water views
 9.6 km right curve 13th Line Rd – on left
 10.9 km left turn Highway 96 east – paved
 12.8 km left curve South Shore Rd on right – channel view
 13.2 km right curve Holliday Rd – on left
 14.5 km on right 14th Line Rd – watch for planes landing

 19.2 km left turn Breakey's Bay Rd – watch for wildlife
 20.6 km right curve 18th Line Rd – steep downhill route
 21.0 km crosses Culvert – water view – steep uphill route
 21.3 km on left Inukshuk, deer in fields
 22.1 km left turn Highway 96 – paved
 24.8 km on left 20th Line Rd
 26.0 km end of highway Port Metcalfe-Howe Island view

Route #2 - The Head Loop (18 km)**OUTWARD LEG**

0.0 km west on Main St Depart Tourist Centre through village
 0.2 km up Lambert's Hill Take Highway 96 west
 0.3 km on left Trinity Anglican Church
 0.4 km down hill, right Hillcrest St – on left
 1.5 km on right Mill Point Rd, wetlands, view Garden Island
 1.6 km up hill Marsh/wetlands on right, birds too
 2.0 km on left 5th Line Rd, view of Kingston on right
 2.8 km on left 4th Line Rd, watch for cows & golfers
 3.0 km on right Old shoreline road
 3.3 km up hill Greenwood cottage hill
 4.5 km on left 3rd Line Rd, view Simcoe Island on right
 4.7 km on right Look for cottage with widow's walk
 5.4 km on right Simcoe Island Ferry Road
 5.6 km on left Wind anemometer test site
 6.0 km turn left Sandy Bay Rd/2nd Line Road – gravel
 6.7 km on right Grimshaw Bay (Little Sandy Bay)
 6.7 km on left Large wetlands, birds & marsh animals
 6.9 km crosses Large culvert through marsh/wetlands
 8.3 km turn left Baseline Rd
 9.6 km crosses 3rd Line Rd
 10.3 km on right Look for horses
 11.0 km turn left 4th Line Rd. – rugged, wild asparagus
 12.4 km curve left S-curve
 14.0 km crosses Watch for cows and golf balls

RETURN LEG

14.4 km turn right Highway 96 – paved road
 15.0 km on right 5th Line Rd.
 15.1 km down hill Highway 96 – curved road
 16.2 km on left Mill Point Rd. – marsh/wetland
 17.1 km up hill Highway 96
 17.2 km on right Hillcrest Street
 17.3 km on right Trinity Anglican Church
 17.5 km on right Highway 95
 18.0 km end Tourist Information Centre

Route #3 - Button Bay Loop (28 km)**OUTWARD LEG**

0.0 km east on Main St. Depart Tourist Centre through village
 0.6 km on right 7th Line Rd – gravel
 0.8 km on left Watch for herons in bay
 2.0 km turn right 8th Line Rd- wetland on left
 2.3 km up hill Look for horses & deer
 3.5 km on right Picturesque limestone block house
 3.7 km turn left Baseline Rd
 4.6 km on left Old farm buildings, woods, wildlife
 5.1 km right curve 9th Line Rd – wetlands, hills & creeks
 6.3 km on left Wilmer Rd
 6.9 km on right Old wind generator/TV tower
 7.4 km on right Old School house #8
 7.5 km on right Reed's Bay Rd
 8.7 km on left Carpenter Point Rd – watch for golfers
 9.3 km right curve Bennet Rd
 10.8 km crosses 8th Line Rd – series of small hills
 12.2 km turn left 7th Line Rd – water & USA view, woods
 12.8 km curve turn right Short Rd
 13.0 km turn left Button Bay Rd
 13.5 km on right Old hand water pump
 14.0 km crosses Woods, streams, wetlands
 14.3 km turn left Highway 95 – paved road
 14.6 km on left Cemetery, woods, deer & wild turkeys
 16.4 km highway ends Horne's Ferry to the USA

RETURN LEG

16.4 km depart Horne's Highway 95 north - paved
 18.5 km on right 7th Line Rd
 19.2 km curve right Watch for deer crossing!
 20.4 km on left Buffalo in pens & field
 21.0 km on left Wind anemometer test site
 21.5 km on right Domestic deer
 21.8 km crosses Button Bay Rd and Ridge Rd
 23.0 km crosses Reed's Bay Rd
 23.4 km crosses Creek – watch for turtles
 24.4 km on right CKWS TV tower
 25.4 km crosses Baseline Rd
 27.1 km on right Ambulance & Fire Hall
 27.2 km on right Sacred Heart Cemetery
 27.5 km on left Sacred Heart Church
 27.7 km turn right Highway 96 intersection
 28.0 km end Tourist Information Centre
